Dr Stephen Faleti holds a Bachelor's degree in Political Science as well as Master's and Doctorate degrees in Peace and Conflict Studies from the University of Ibadan. He is a Research Fellow on the Peace & Conflict Studies program of the University of Ibadan where he leads the Environment and Conflicts specialisation. He also teaches on the postgraduate programme in the Centre for Sustainable Development, University of Ibadan and the West Africa Peacebuilding Institute at the Koffi Annan International Peacekeeping Training Centre in Accra, Ghana. He has also lectured as an adjunct staff on the Peace & Strategic Studies Programme of the University of Ilorin and the Peace & Conflict Resolution unit of the National Open University of Nigeria (NOUN).

Apart from sundry publications covering environmental, national security and crisis management issues, he has authored courseware for the teaching of peace studies in the National Open University of Nigeria including the Modules on 'Ethnic Conflicts and Resolution' and 'Education for Peace.'
